wall, and a door having pivots received in said gaps to pivotally mount the door between said flange extensions and wall.

2. In a toy house, a two-piece door construction com-

prising; a wall having a door opening therein defined by 5 top, bottom, and side flanges perpendicular to said wall and integral therewith; one end of each of said top and bottom flanges being spaced from the corresponding end of one of said side flanges to provide a pair of aligned gaps; an integral extension on said top flange and an 10 integral extension on the side flange between said gaps;

the said extensions lying in said opening and spaced from said wall; and a door having pivotal extensions received in said aligned gaps to pivotally mount the door in said opening between said flange extensions and said wall.
